Why invest in United Way?

United Way of Sullivan County knows that people like you really want to make a difference in our community. We want to be your partner.

Our experience tells us that the best way to help the most people is to target our community's most serious problems—and then focus on the underlying causes of those problems. It takes the whole community—working together—to pull it off. We bring together people from all across the community—people from government, business, faith groups, nonprofits and ordinary citizens—to tackle the issues that matter most.

We are different than other non-profit organizations. We can use our size to drive efficiencies of tens of thousands of local agencies, by providing resources and focusing their efforts on achieving a common goal. One dollar per pay period can help bring a meal to a senior, provide counseling to an at-risk teen and support after school programs.

Partnering

Your United Way isn't just a fund-raising organization. The United Way of Sullivan County works in close partnership with local schools, businesses, charities and government to assess and address the needs of the community.

Giving

Giving is a personal decision. Many choose to donate the equivalent of one hour of work per month. For those who make \$5.00 per hour that would be \$60.00 per year. (\$5.00 x 12 months).

Flexibility

If you do not choose a specific agency for your donation, the United Way of Sullivan County will make sure that it is directed to an agency addressing a critical need in this community. The United Way has a Budget and Allocations Committee to assess these needs and agencies. Of course if you wish, you may designate your contribution to go to any not-for-profit 501-C3 agency by noting their name and address on the pledge card.

Allocations & Accountability

The United Way of Sullivan County is governed by a local Board of Directors, who throughout the year analyzes community needs, monitor supported programs, and controls how community funds are raised and distributed. The Budget and Allocations Committee determines how flexible (undesignated) contributions will be distributed to local agencies.

As a donor, you have the right to specify the organization that will receive your donated fund. United Way distributes the funds to local agencies and programs unless otherwise designated.
